

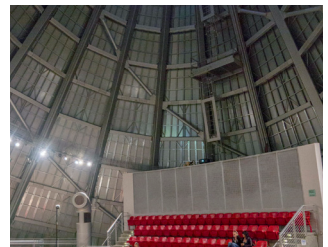

INTRODUCTION

The award-winning Museum of Glass opened in 2002 and includes pieces by renowned local glass artist Dale Chihuly. The 75,000 sq. ft. building's most striking feature is the 90 foot cone that houses the Hot Shop Amphitheater, where visitors can watch artists blow glass. Wasser's MC-Aluminum was applied to all the steel framework inside the cone, to the exposed ceilings in the museum, as well as to the handrails and stairwell risers.
