A steel bulkhead serviced by the U.S. Coast Guard in South Portland required a high-performance coating system to protect against constant saltwater exposure, tidal fluctuations, and harsh coastal conditions. These aggressive elements accelerate corrosion and structural degradation, particularly in the splash and tidal zones. The project required a durable solution that could be applied efficiently while ensuring long-term protection of critical marine infrastructure.
